

GIRLS UNIFORM

The School's uniform has been designed for comfort and to encourage personal grooming and students' pride in their appearance. All students must wear their uniform to and from school and on all official school occasions.

Senior Girl's Uniform (Years 11-13)

Winter

Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with W.H.S. monogram
White overblouse short or long sleeved blouse buttoned to the neck worn with regulation tie (long sleeved blouse must be worn for formal assemblies and occasions)
Red school tie
Regulation Black Watch tartan kilt (45/55 wool polyester mix) purchased through the school
Navy blue wool/lycra or opaque stockings or over the knee stockings
Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, low heel and able to take polish
Black puffer jacket

Summer

Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with W.H.S. monogram
Regulation Black Watch tartan Skirt purchased through the school worn at the waist and to the knee
Short sleeved white overblouse
White ankle socks to be worn at the ankles (8-12cm high)
Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, low heel and able to take polish

Junior Girl's Uniform (Year 7-10)

Winter

Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with W.H.S. monogram
White overblouse long sleeves – tucked in
Regulation Black Watch tartan kilt (45/55 wool polyester mix) purchased through the school
Navy blue wool/lycra or opaque stockings or over the knee stockings
Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, low heel and able to take polish
Black puffer jacket

Summer

Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with W.H.S. monogram
Green check dress
White ankle socks to be worn at the ankles (8-12cm high)
Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, low heel and able to take polish

Physical Education

Polo shirt in house colours ie. Leadbetter—Royal Blue,
Pitcaithly— White, Grant—Tomato red, Chisholm— Forest green.
CCC Navy Tactic shorts
A conventional tracksuit may be worn for P.E. with teacher's permission, but regulation shorts must be worn underneath.
Optional: School blazer with pocket monogram – Year 11 and up

General

1. All items of uniform must be permanently named and maintained in a clean and tidy condition.
2. Hair is to be worn in a neat and tidy style. Hair that hangs below base of blouse to be tied back. For safety reasons hair must be fully tied back in specialist classes. Accessories should be in school colours.
3. A necklace appropriate to students culture may be worn e.g. maori taonga.
4. Jewellery is not be worn to school except for a watch, a necklace, a single bracelet, a maximum of two studs or small sleepers in each ear, a small nose stud, a small flat finger ring. No other visible jewellery is permitted. No visible tattoos permitted.
5. A light covering of foundation may be worn. No eye makeup or coloured nail polish to be worn.
6. The black puffer jacket may be worn with school uniform.
7. Year 13 students have permission to wear appropriate casual clothes (mufti) in Term 4.
8. Approval for any temporary variation from the uniform code must be obtained from a Deputy Principal.
9. Coloured tops should not be worn under the white blouse.
