

The school's uniform has been designed for comfort and to encourage students' pride in their appearance. All students must wear their uniform to and from school and on all official school occasions.

## SENIOR BOY'S UNIFORM (YEARS 11-13)

## Winter

- Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with dove monogram
- White long or short-sleeved shirt (tailed shirts to be worn tucked in) with red school tie
- Mid-grey school trousers to be worn above hips with a brown or black belt (these must be worn for formal assemblies and occasions) or bottle green walk shorts, worn above knees with green belt supplied with shorts
- Waimate High School socks
- Black regulation, lace-up, leather dress shoes, low heel, and able to take polish
- Black puffer jacket
- Optional: School blazer with pocket monogram


## Summer

- White shirt (short or long-sleeved) straight across back style shirt preferred, any tailed shirts to be worn tucked in.
- Bottle green walk shorts: worn above knees with green belt supplied with shorts
- Fawn socks
- Black regulation, lace-up, leather dress shoes, low heel, and able to take polish


## JUNIOR BOY'S UNIFORM (YEARS 7-10)

## Winter

- Bottle green regulation V neck jersey or vest with dove monogram
- Grey lightweight long sleeved shirt: tailed shirts to be worn tucked in
- Grey Kaiapoi Collegiate shorts or mid-grey school trousers
- Waimate High School socks
- Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, low heel and able to take polish
- Black puffer jacket


## Summer

- Grey, lightweight, short-sleeved shirt - straight across back style
- Grey drill shorts to be worn above the knees
- Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, low heel and able to take polish
- Fawn socks


## PHYSICAL EDUCATION (YEARS 7-13)

- PE tops: navy and white with school logo and name. Order through Uniform Room (or Office)
- CCC Navy Tactic shorts
- A conventional tracksuit may be worn for PE with teacher's permission, but regulation shorts must be worn underneath.


## GENERAL GUIDELINES

- All items of uniform must be permanently named and maintained in a clean and tidy condition.
- Hair is to be worn in a neat and tidy style.
- For safety reasons hair must be fully tied back in specialist classes. Accessories should be in school colours.
- A necklace appropriate to a student's culture may be worn e.g. Māori taonga.
- Students may wear the following jewellery: a watch, a necklace, a single bracelet, a maximum of two studs or small sleepers in each ear, a small nose stud, a small flat finger ring.
- The black puffer jacket may be worn with school uniform.
- Year 13 students have permission to wear appropriate casual clothes in Term 4.
- Approval for any temporary variation from the uniform code must be obtained from a Senior Leader.
- Coloured tops should not be worn under the white shirt.

## SENIOR GIRL'S UNIFORM (YEARS 11-13)

## Winter

- Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with dove monogram
- White short or long-sleeved, stiff-collared blouse buttoned to the neck worn with red school tie
- Regulation Black Watch tartan kilt (45/55 wool polyester mix) purchased through the school
- Navy blue wool/lycra or opaque stockings or over the knee stockings
- Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, or black T-Bars, low heel, and able to take polish
- Black puffer jacket
- Optional: School blazer with pocket monogram


## Summer

- Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with dove monogram
- Regulation Black Watch tartan skirt purchased through the school worn at the waist and to the knee
- Short-sleeved white overblouse
- White ankle socks to be worn at the ankles
- Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, or black T-Bars, low heel and able to take polish


## JUNIOR GIRL'S UNIFORM (YEARS 7-10)

## Winter

- Bottle green regulation $V$ neck jersey with dove monogram
- White short or long-sleeved blouse
- Regulation Black Watch tartan kilt (45/55 wool polyester mix) purchased through the school
- Navy blue wool/lycra or opaque stockings or over the knee stockings
- Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, low heel and able to take polish
- Black puffer jacket


## Summer

- Bottle green regulation V neck jersey with dove monogram
- Green check dress
- White ankle socks to be worn at the ankles
- Black regulation lace-up leather dress shoes, or black T-Bars, low heel and able to take polish

- CCC Navy Tactic shorts
